- Have they participated and/or helped with State Fair, WSCA, 4-H, Breed organizations or other horse activities?
- Other activities or traits which make the person a role model and/or leader among horse people.

#### **GUIDELINES FOR "HORSE OF THE YEAR"**

- Has the horse had multiple owners/riders or a special relationship with one rider?
- Consider the career of the horse in SCSCA.
- Has the horse had some "special years"?
- Traits that make the horse special.
- Consider the awards won or performance attributes.
- Accomplishments in youth, senior, 4-H, or other areas beyond SCSCA.
